Indoor Performance Information & Procedures

1. Buses and equipment trucks will park as directed by host guides.
2. Band directors will need to check in at the Contest Headquarters in the lobby of the Beickman Performing Arts Center.
3. Band members should stay on buses. Host guides will lead the band members from the buses to the appropriate areas inside the school for warm up and performance.
4. Performance Procedure;
Five Bands will be inside the building at one time. We will use radio communication to coordinate the schedule. Each group will get at least their allotted time for warm up and performance.
Example: Band #1 Performance in McCuen Gym
 Band #2 Warm-up A - Activity Center
 Band #3 Warm-up B - BPAC Stage
 Band #4 Pre warm-up A - Swimming Pool Lobby
 Band #5 Pre warm-up B - Band Room 406
5. Pit percussion will only be allowed in the performance area. Only 2 pit percussion units will be in the building at one time - the group in performance and the group on deck. Please bring something to cover and protect your equipment. It will remain outside until approximately 13 minutes prior to performance.
6. After the band has performed, the host guide will lead them back to the buses. Afterwards students may come back into the gym and sit in areas that are not being used by spectators.
7. Your buses will be your home room. We will communicate with you by coming to your buses.
8. Dressing areas will NOT be provided. Uniforms are not required for indoor performance. If you wish to dress you must use your buses. The building will be too congested to allow for dressing areas.
9. In case of a delay during the contest, directors should report to the Contest Headquarters, the BPAC Lobby, for further instructions.
10. Spectators will enter the building at the McCuen Gym entrance.
