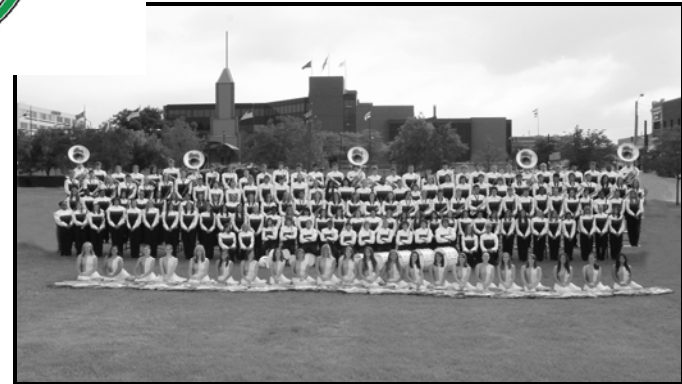

## Expectations

**Proper rehearsal techniques** are expected at all times.

- Listen carefully and follow instructions.
- Sit/stand with proper posture and instrument position as determined by the classroom teacher.
- Have all necessary equipment, music and a pencil.
- Show respect to all people and property.

**All music equipment** is to be treated with respect, well maintained, and stored properly.

**School owned instruments** are not to be loaned to others. The student renting the school instrument is responsible for all repairs.

**Gum, candy, food and beverages**, other than water, are not permitted in the music rehearsal rooms, BPAC, or lobby.

## Attendance

Attendance is required at all rehearsals and performances unless excused in advance by Mrs. Burton.

### Tardy

Students will be considered tardy if they are not past the following designated marks when the tardy bell rings:

- Indoor Band – doorway to 405
- Percussion and Woodwinds – doorway to 406 hallway
- Brass and Color Guard – doorway to 315 hallway
- For rehearsals and performances occurring outside of the regular school day, students must be in their designated areas, and completely ready, when rehearsal begins.

### Tardy Policy - Concord Student Handbook

Each tardy occurrence will result in a loss of 30 points towards the student's daily band grade. If a student receives more than 4 tardies during a trimester, school disciplinary action as described in the student handbook will take place.

Unexcused Tardy, or Absence, may result in loss of marching eligibility.

**Appropriate Classroom Behavior** is expected at all times in accordance with the guidelines set forth in the Concord High School Student handbook. Inappropriate behavior will result in:

**1<sup>st</sup> time: Verbal reprimand**, documentation, and possible disciplinary action.

**2<sup>nd</sup> time: Parent notification**, verbal reprimand, documentation, and possible disciplinary action

**3<sup>rd</sup> time: Student is excluded from class** for the remainder of the period, notification to administrative offices, parent notification, verbal reprimand, and documentation.

**4<sup>th</sup> time: Referral form to the office.** Student is excluded from class for the remainder of the period. School administration will determine the appropriate disciplinary action.

## Grades

The following categories will be used when determining grades.

-Daily class work, including preparation, attitude & effort

-Tests

-Attendance (point system) for each class, rehearsal and performance.

**The 100-point system** is used to determine each student's grade for each class, rehearsal, and performance. 100 = present, on time, with all necessary equipment, no problems

### **Grades that may be restored up to 100 points with properly completed make-up work.**

70 = tardy or missed any part of rehearsal or performance, if excused

1 = no equipment, if excused

0 = absent, if excused

### **Grades that may not be restored**

74 = no pencil

73 = no music/notebook

72 = improper care of equipment

71 = improper rehearsal technique

69 = disruptive behavior

68 = gum, food or beverage

50 = serious problem

40 = multiple reasons for grade lowered

### **All make-up work is due 5 school days after returning to class.**

- It is the responsibility of the student to request make-up assignments and to complete and return a make-up form if they are absent or miss any part of a rehearsal or performance.
